

Tanzania Civil Aviation Authority has organized two important consultative meetings scheduled for 22 and 23 October, 2008 at Kilimanjaro Kempinsk Hotel.

On 22 October, the Authority will consult with her stakeholders to get their inputs into the Second Five Years Strategic Plan (2009/10 - 2013/14) which the authority expects to adopt from next financial year.

The First Five Years Strategic Plan that started in the year 2004/05 ends in June 2009. While winding up the first Five years Strategic Plan, the Authority plan to critically examine the current challenges, learn from the experiences of the last five years and come up with a relatively new strategic Plan which will steer the Authority for the coming five years.

On 23 October, the Authority's Board of Directors will consider and deliberate among other issues, application for Air Services and Ground Handling Services Licenses from different companies and operators.

The Operators applying for Air Services License are 26, of which 17 are new operators while applying for Ground Handling Services Licenses are six.
