1. These Regulations may be cited as the Civil Aviation (Certification, Licensing and Registration of Aerodromes) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026 and shall be read as one with the Civil Aviation (Certification, Licensing and Registration of Aerodromes) Regulations, 2024, hereinafter referred to as the “principal Regulations”.

2. The principal Regulations are amended in regulation 5 by deleting paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) and substituting for them the following:

“ (a) Category A comprising aerodromes designated for use by all types of aircraft and available for use by both domestic and international air traffic with air traffic services provided on 24 hours basis;

- (b) Category B comprising aerodromes designated for use by all types of aircraft and available for use by both international and domestic air traffic, where the formalities of customs immigration, health and similar formalities are available at all times or upon prior notice;
- (c) Category C comprising aerodromes designated for use by all types of aircraft and available for use by domestic air traffic;”.
