**RE: RESUMPTION OF KENYAN FLIGHTS TO THE UNITED REPUBLIC  
OF TANZANIA  
PRESS RELEASE**

This is to confirm that the Government of the Republic of Kenya, through its Circular issued by Kenya Civil Aviation Authority on 15 September 2020, removed the requirement of 14 days mandatory quarantine for all arriving passengers from the United Republic of Tanzania.

In view of that and on a reciprocal basis, the United Republic of Tanzania has now lifted the suspension for all Kenyan Operators namely, Kenya Airways, Fly 540 Limited, Safarilink Aviation and AirKenya Express Limited.

For the purpose of this release therefore, the resumption and restoration of flights for all Kenyan operators is with immediate effect and Kenya Civil Aviation Authority has been informed accordingly.

The United Republic of Tanzania shall always strive to adhere to the fundamental principles of Chicago Convention 1944 and Bilateral Air Services Agreement between two States.
