VALIDATION AND CONVERSION OF FOREIGN LICENSES PROCEDURE

A. VALIDATION

Validation of Foreign licenses in accordance with the Civil Aviation (Personnel Licensing) Regulations 2017, Part III is affected by the Tanzania Civil Aviation Authority (TCAA) only in exceptional cases and for specific purposes, e.g. for ferry, demonstration, or training flights. This method of recognizing a foreign license is not generally used in cases where a license holder is seeking regular employment as an aircrew of Tanzania registered aircraft. In such cases, the applicant should apply to the Director General, Tanzania Civil Aviation Authority for conversion terms.

The following conditions will apply for license validation

- i. submit a copy of another contracting state license;
- ii. copy of passport
- iii. last three pages of log-books for assessments
- iv. Pass the medical examination Class 1
- v. Pass the Air Law
- vi. Submit a relevant permit(s) or an employment contract or an agreement with one of the prospective air operators or any other locally registered Organization.

B. CONVERSION OF PILOT LICENSES.

Where a holder of a current foreign license wishes to convert to a Tanzanian license, the following conditions will apply in each of the particular cases set out below:

1. THE HOLDER OF AN A.T.P.L. OR C.P.L. FROM ANOTHER CONTRACTING STATE WITH AN INSTRUMENT RATING APPLYING FOR AN EQUIVALENT TANZANIAN LICENSE SHALL:

Meet all the requirements in Regulations 21(1)(2)(3) and (4) of the Civil Aviation (Personnel Licensing) Regulations, 2017. In addition, the pilot shall possess and submit a relevant permit(s) or an employment contract or an agreement with one of the prospective air operators or any other locally registered Organization; including the following;

- i. Pass the conversion examination of the license sought
- ii. Pass General flight test of the type sought
- iii. Pass the medical examination Class 1

2. THE HOLDER OF AN EAST AFRICA COMMUNITY STATE (EAC)) A.T.P.L OR CPL APPLYING FOR AN EQUIVALENT TANZANIAN LICENSE SHALL:

Meet all the requirements in Regulations 21(1)(2)(3) and (4) of the Civil Aviation (Personnel Licensing) Regulations, 2017. In addition, the pilot shall possess and submit a relevant permit(s) or an employment contract or an agreement with one of the prospective air operators or any other locally registered Organization; including the following;

- i. Pass the Airlaw examination,
- ii. Pass General flight test of the type sought, and
- iii. Pass the medical examination Class 1

Candidates who fail the above papers may be referred for re-examination. Candidates who fail to pass the above examination in three attempts will not be accepted for further examination until a period of one month has elapsed from the date of the last examination.
