**STAKEHOLDER CONSULTATION MEETING ON THE REVIEW OF THE
DRAFT NEW AND AMENDED CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS, 2026**

The Tanzania Civil Aviation Authority (TCAA), pursuant to the directive of the Ministry of Transport, hereby invites aviation industry stakeholders and other interested members of the public to participate in stakeholder consultations meeting on the **Review of the Draft New and Amended Civil Aviation Regulations, 2026**. The consultations are intended to obtain stakeholders' views and comments on the proposed draft Regulations before their finalization, with the objective of enhancing the safety, security, efficiency, and sustainable development of the civil aviation sector in Tanzania.

The stakeholder consultative meetings will be held from 9th to 10th July 2026 at the Alpha Conference Hall, TCAA Headquarters, Aviation House, Nyerere/Kitunda Road Junction, Banana Area, Ukonga, Dar es Salaam.

The draft Regulations to be discussed are:

- a) The Civil Aviation (Remotely Piloted Aircraft) Regulations, 2026;
- b) The Civil Aviation (Aeronautical Radio Frequency Spectrum Utilization) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026;
- c) The Civil Aviation (Heliports) Regulations, 2026;
- d) The Civil Aviation (Operation of Aircraft – Commercial Air Transport) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026;
- e) The Civil Aviation (Personnel Licensing) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026;
- f) The Civil Aviation (Ground Handling Services) Regulations, 2026;
- g) The Civil Aviation (Safety Management System) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026;
- h) The Civil Aviation (Radio Navigation Aids) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026;
- i) The Civil Aviation (Security) (Amendment) Regulations, 2026;
- j) The Civil Aviation (Communication Systems and Procedures Relating to Remotely Piloted Aircraft Systems C2 Link) Regulations, 2026. and
- k) The Civil Aviation (Meteorological Service for Air Navigation) Regulations, 2026
